Public Notice Class 1 pursuant to s.985.07(1), stats

Please take notice that Coulee Frac Sand, LLC is applying for a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit on November 21, 2018 for a proposed nonmetallic mine at the following location: NW NW, Section 8 T24N R2E Town of Rock. Property owned by John Franseen, Donald Helgersen and Carbo Ceremics.

This Permit ensures the proper reclamation of the nonmetallic mine. The nonmetallic mine will be mined for industrial sand. The nonmetallic mine will be reclaimed in phases occurring on an ongoing basis. All slopes and disturbed areas will be top soiled, seeded and monitored with the main reclamation goal being an emergent wetland surrounding a shallow open-water lake. The reclamation will follow the standards of the Wood County Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance 802.

Any person residing within, owning property within, or whose principal place of business is within 300 feet of the boundary of the parcel in which the nonmetallic mining site is proposed may request a public hearing on reclamation only if requested within 30 days of the actual date of this public notice.
